Every once in awhile, you end up with an extra page at the end of a portable document files (PDF). In my example, it's page 5. Here's how to delete it.

1. With your cursor on the page you want to delete, from the MenuBar, select Document ► Delete Pages (Figure 1).

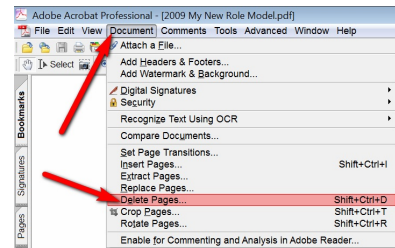

2. The 'Delete Pages' window (Figure 2) will appear. Either left-click on the "OK" button or touch the Enter key on your keyboard.

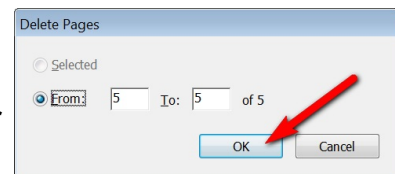

3. The confirmation window will appear (Figure 3). Either left-click on the "OK" button or touch the Enter key on your keyboard.

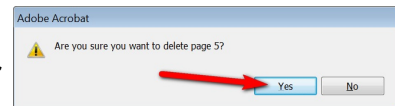

4. SAVE your changes (Figure 4).

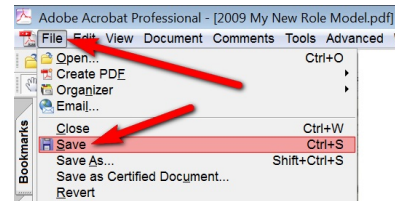
