➤ 'MarlinJim', Sep/9/19: My sister is going on the *Carnival Dream* in May 2010, and they offer a happy hour for their Meet and Mingle. Has anyone ever heard if Royal Caribbean does anything like this? And if so, would anyone be interested in this for our meet and mingle?

This is what Carnival offers:

➤ 1 hour open bar with dry snacks. \$9.95 plus 15%. We need at 20 people. They assign you a lounge and it will have a bar with a bartender that will fix your drinks anyway you want them. It will also include non-alcohol drinks for the ones that don't drink. I prefer this option. But I will go with any of them.

➤ 1.5 hours, \$14.50 same as above

➤ 2 hours, \$17 same as above.

They have many more options, but I think these would work just fine.

➤ 'RetDon', Sep/9/19: I know RCI offers groups a cocktail parties based on the number of cabins booked. I am co-chair of our 52nd high school reunion on FOS 10-10-2010 and they said if we book 30 cabins we get a free cocktail party for the group.

➤ 'MarlinJim', Sep/21/09: This is what [Royal Caribbean Line] sent to me:

Below you can find all the information and prices for a cocktail party, you need to have a minimum of 16 guests. Venues like this one are held on one of the Lounge, it must be approved by the onboard group coordinator.

If you want to reserve the cocktail party, you need to provide a lead booking # and also the name and the reservation # of the guest that will be paying for this function with the SeaPass Card onboard.

Flat rates per person (16 guests minimum for at least one hour).

- House — \$12.25 (per person/1 hour)
- Call — \$15.25 (per person/1 hour)
- Premium — \$18.25 (per person/1 hour)
- Super Premium- \$21.25 (per person/1 hour)
- Beer/Wine/Soda — \$11.25 (per person/1 hour)
- Sparkling wine — \$9.25 (per person/1 hour)
- Champagne — \$22.25 (per person/1 hour)
- Non-Alcoholic — \$8.25 (per person/1 hour). Non-alcoholic includes assorted sodas and water.
- 15% Gratuity will be applied to the total price of the Bar package.
- House, Call, Premium, & Super Premium parties include beer, wines by the glass, soda, juice and mixers.
