



# NASSAU

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➤ 'WannaSail4ever', Aug/1/09: We did a walking tour around downtown Nassau. It's not that large and if you'd like to see the **Governor's Mansion** and a few museums, churches, etc., it's an easy walk. We also walked over to the **British Colonial Hilton** to check out its beach. The garden is beautiful and there is a nice pool. The beach is not that large there, but then your only other real option is **Cabbage Beach** by Atlantis or **Cable Beach** on the other end of Nassau. I did not notice them dredging sand, but then they could have been. We then went over to **Atlantis** (\$4 per person for taxi or \$6 per person water taxi) at **Paradise Beach**. What a gorgeous place to go. For \$35 per person, you can have access to all of the grounds including the aquariums plus "The Dig". You are *not* allowed to use their pools or beaches. It's huge and just a tour of the place provides a pretty good day. The **aquariums** are great and the **casino** is huge. Even if you don't pay the extra money, you can still see a lot of the aquarium from the lower level of the hotel itself. I am told that you can get a room at the sister property, I think it's a **Comfort Suites** across the street, and have full use of the property for the day, including beaches, pools, water slides and toys. I have also been on the **Snorkel Tour** to Athol Island several times. It's pretty good. Not the best, but still good. Usually, that's done on a catamaran or good sized boat. It's a deep water snorkel.

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
