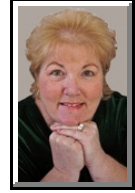


INSERTING A PHOTO INTO A CRUISECRITIC COMMENT

Sometimes nothing can suffice explaining a point better than a photo. When using *CruiseCritic* boards < <http://boards.cruisecritic.com/> >, the process for inserting a photo in your comment is quite simple.

1. Upload your photos to a website.

While I have my own website, I use Picasa, from Google, which can be downloaded for free from <http://picasa.google.com/thanks.html>. The software helps you upload photos to a free website like mine at <http://picasaweb.google.com/PegEggFL> .

2. Once the photo is uploaded, go to the photo and double, left-click on it to maximize it. (Otherwise you get only the thumbnail which is a tiny photo.)

3. Then RIGHT-click on the photo.

4. Left-click on “Copy” in the popup menu.

5. Then go to the CruiseCritic Boards:

① Write your comment first, otherwise it’s either hard to resume writing or a large open space is left in your comment.

② Left-click where you want the photo.

③ RIGHT-click at that same spot.

④ Left-click on the “Paste” option in the popup menu.

6. That’s it. There is no copying the website address or any fancy stuff.
