

HILDRETH FAMILY ASSOCIATION ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

This Association is formed for the purpose of organizing into a friendly union and for the common good of all persons in America who have a Hildreth ancestor or who are united in marriage to those who have a Hildreth ancestor, having in mind, but not necessarily limited to, the descendants of the two Puritan forefathers who bore the name of Hildreth—one by the name of RICHARD HILDRETH, who appeared in Cambridge, Mass., in 1643 as a Freeman in the Massachusetts Bay Colony and who died in Chelmsford, Mass., in 1693, the other by the name of THOMAS HILDRETH who appeared also in 1643 as one of the first settlers of Southampton (Long Island), N.Y. and who died there in 1657.
