

Internet Explorer OPEN A NEW WINDOW

Here's a common annoyance: You're on the Web doing online banking or some other important task when you get an e-mail.

Opening email in Outlook Express and clicking on the embedded Web link opens the site in your existing Internet Explorer window, taking you away from your banking.

Wouldn't it be nice if the link opened a new browser window? Here's how:

❶ From the Desktop, select:
Start > Control Panel (*Windows XP*)
Start > Settings > Control Panel
(*Windows 98/Me*)

❷ Double-click on Internet Options.

❸ Select the Advanced tab (Figure 1).

❹ Scroll down to the Browsing section and look for an entry called: "Re-use Windows for launching shortcuts".

❺ Remove the checkmark from the box (Figure 2) and click OK button.

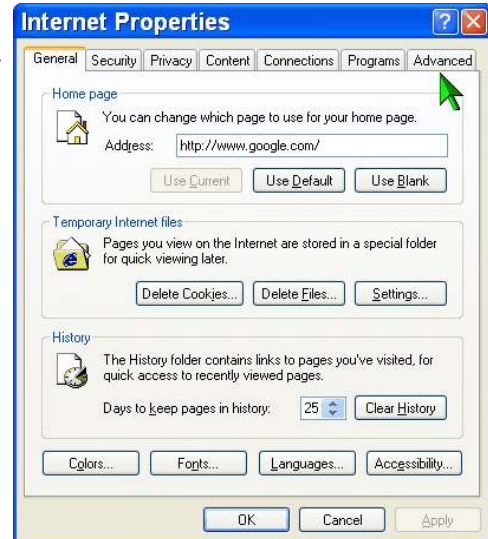

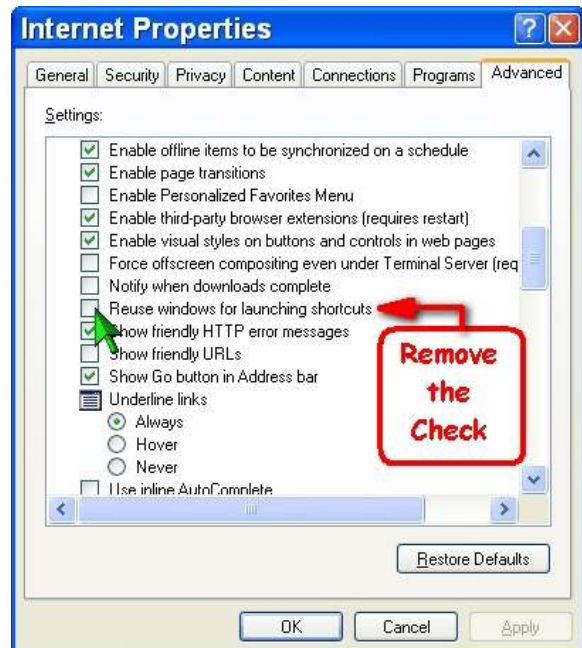
