# SECURITY SETTING

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**HELP:** I can't login to anything in Internet Explorer. Last night, I wanted to check out our reservation on Air Tran. Could not go there. I got a message saying "Java script()" and then "Done". The same thing happened with Ancestry.com and Genealogy.com. So I tried tbpac.org. There I got a message saying "Security setting don't allow ActiveX". What do I need to do about this?

The problem is a setting in your Internet Options.  
Here's how to solve your problem.

1. From the Desktop, select Start > Control Panel.
2. Double-click on "Internet Options."
3. Click on the "Security" tab.
4. Click on the "Custom Level" button, at the bottom of the window.
5. Ensure that the "ActiveX controls and plug-ins" has the "Enable" with a dot in it. It is the third item down in the open window (**Figure 1**).
6. Touch the *Enter* key, on the keyboard, or click on the "OK" button.
7. Touch the *Enter* key, on the keyboard, or click on the "OK" button.
8. Exit the Control Panel window.

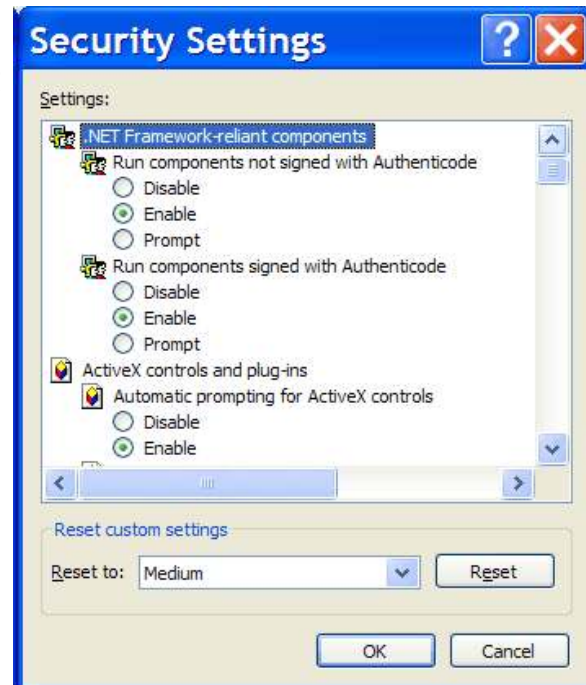
