QUESTION: I want to send someone a specific Webpage, such as David's Links < <http://www.davidslinks.org/> > .

The actual page is found if one clicks on the "Arts" button and then "Digital Photography Composition Tips" (¼ of the way down the page). I'd send just that page, but you'll see that each page is titled exactly as above — <http://www.davidslinks.org/> .

How can I designate the exact page I want someone to view?

ANSWER:

1. RIGHT-click on the page.
2. Left-click on Properties (last choice).
3. Click, hold & drag across the "Address:" (Figure 1).
4. Use Ctrl+C keys, on the keyboard, to copy the address.
5. Use Ctrl+V keys, on the keyboard, to paste it into your word processor or your email.

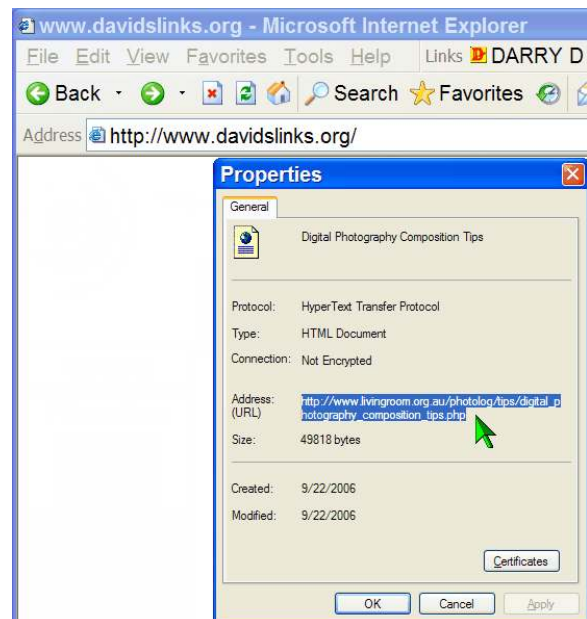
