

ADD WEBSITE SHORTCUT TO WINDOWS DESKTOP

IF you are using cable or Digital Subscriber Line (DSL), it will save you a lot of time if you place a shortcut to favorite Website. Here's how to do that.

1. Using Internet Explorer, go to the Website.
2. From the MenuBar, select Favorites > Add to Favorites.
3. In the resulting "Add Favorite" window, click on the "OK" button.
4. From the MenuBar, select Favorites and go to the Website you want to add to your Desktop.
5. RIGHT-click on the Website you want to add to your Desktop.
6. Select Send to > Desktop (Create Icon).
7. Unlike in Windows Explorer (when you conduct a similar process), no message will appear on your screen.
8. Minimize all Windows and you'll see your new shortcut added to the end of the existing shortcuts.
