Sometimes, when you want to listen to an online movie or animated graphic, you hear no sound when you should be hearing it. In this case, it's one of two problems; both solved here.

SOUND MUTED.

The first thing to check is the Sound controls next to the Time on the TaskBar at the bottom of the Desktop.

1. If you can not see the speaker icon, click on the left-arrow (Figure 1).

2. Ensure that the Mute is not checked and that the volume control is all the way to the top (Figure 2). If changing either of these solves your problem, you're finished. If not, continue to Step 3.

3. Open the Volume Control:
 - 1 RIGHT-click on the speaker icon.
 - 2 Click on "Open Volume Control".

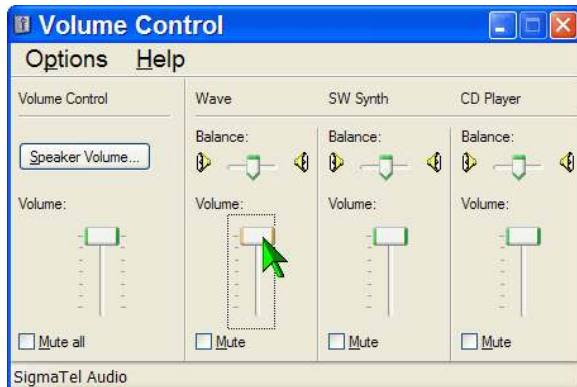

4. The culprit is the "Wave" sound volume. Left-click, hold, and drag on the volume control button and drag it to the top (Figure 4).

5. Problem solved. Exit the window.
