

ADD A BORDER (STROKE)

Here is a way to add a simple border to any photo.

1. With the image in the Editor, use the Ctrl+A key to select all. You'll see "marching ants" along the border (**Figure 1**).

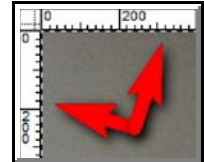

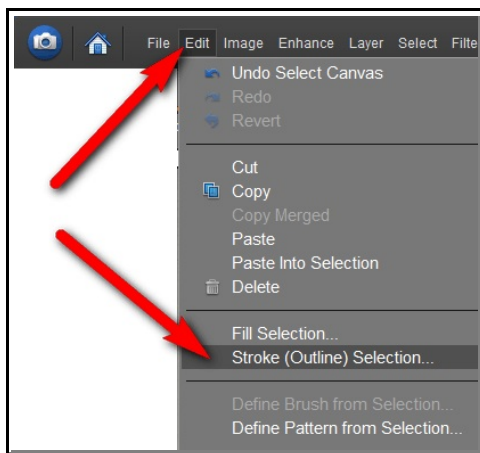

2. From the MenuBar, select Edit ► Stroke (Outline) Selection (**Figure 2**).

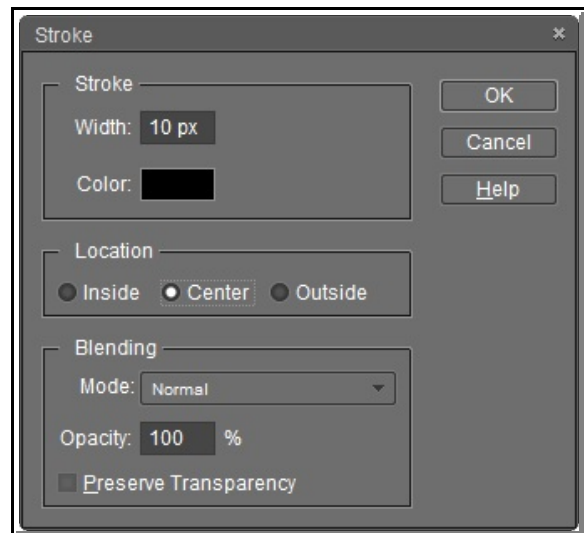

3. Set the Stroke (**Figure 3**):

- ① Set the Width to 10 pixels.
- ② Set the color to the desired color by Left-clicking on the Color "box".
- ③ Set the Location to Center.
- ④ Left-click on "OK" button.

4. SAVE your work by using either the *Ctrl + S* keys, or select *File > Save* from the MenuBar.
