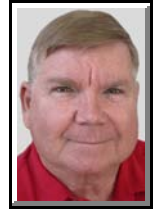


# MENUBAR MISSING IN THE ORGANIZER

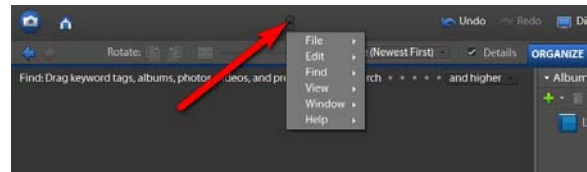
Photoshop Elements 6, like all previous editions has a MenuBar at the top. However, what happens when you open the Organizer, and you don't see it? The problem is that your Windows screen font size is set to a number larger than 96 dpi.

## 1. SOLUTIONS

There are two possible solutions:

- A. Click on the icon (**Figure 1**).
- B. Reduce the Windows screen

font size to 96 dpi.

## 2. REDUCE SCREEN FONT SIZE

- ① From the desktop, choose Start > Control Panel > Display or Start > Settings > Control Panel > Display.
- ② Choose Settings > Advanced.
- ③ Choose Normal Size (96 DPI) from the DPI Settings menu.
- ④ Click OK to the warning
- ⑤ Click Apply.
- ⑥ Click Yes in the General dialog box if it states that the required files are already installed on your Desktop.
- ⑦ Exit the Display Properties
- ⑧ Exit the Control Panel.
- ⑨ Restart your computer.
