

Adobe Photoshop Elements 3 ROTATING AN IMAGE

This quick lesson shows how to rotate an image — usually a photo — in Adobe Photoshop Elements.

1. In the Organizer (“View and Organize Photos” in the opening window):

① Left-click on the photo you want to rotate (Figure 1).

② In this case, click on the “Rotate to the Right” button at the lower-left of the window.

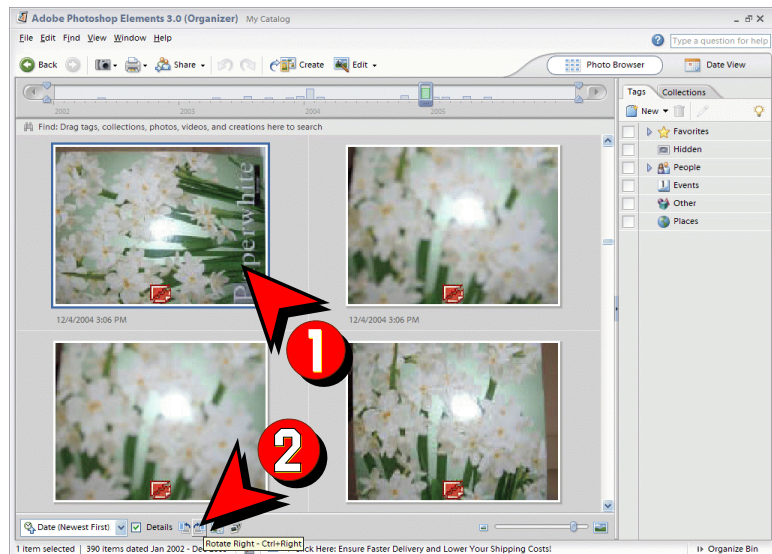

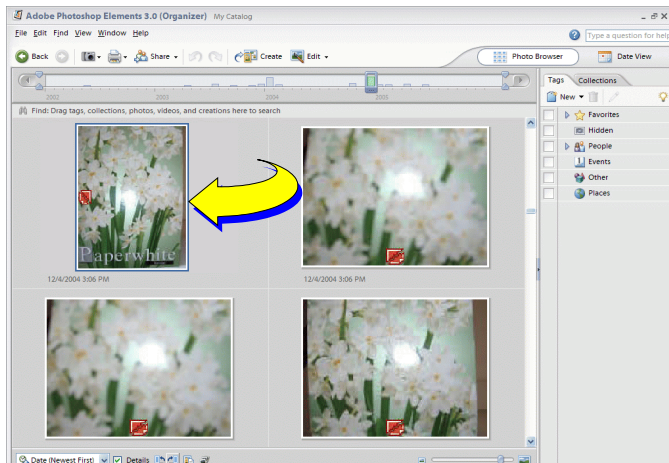

2. The file appears as a corrected photo (arrow in Figure 2).

You can select multiple files by left-clicking on the first one & holding down the Ctrl key while clicking on any number of others. Then left-click on Rotate button (②, paragraph 1) and all photos rotate simultaneously.
