

# Photoshop Elements 5.0

## ROTATE PHOTOS

From time to time, you'll want change the orientation of a photo. Here's how to do it in Elements 5.0.

1. Open the Organizer (**Figure 1**).

- 1 Select the photos you want to rotate:
  - Left-click on the first one.
  - Hold down the Ctrl key and left-click on any number of others.
- 2 Left-click on the appropriate arrow — left-rotate (90-degrees) or right-rotate (90-degrees).

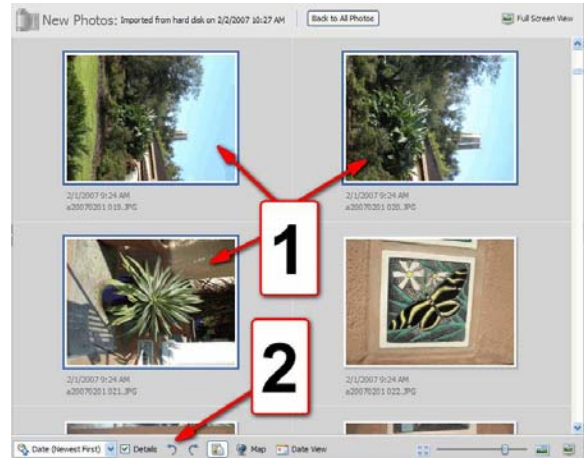

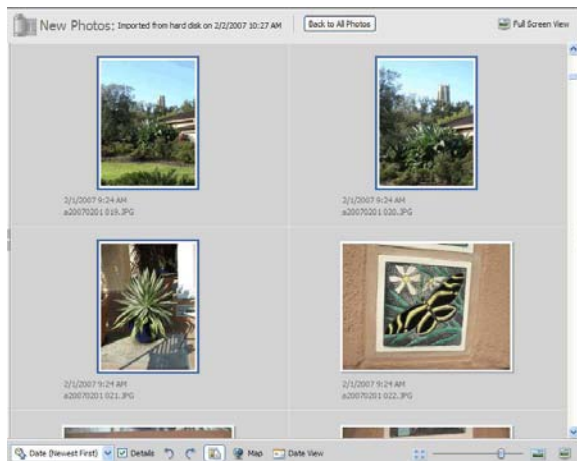

2. The selected photos are rotated (**Figure 2**).

3. You do *not* need to use File > Save or File > Save As because the changes are made automatically.

4. If you make a mistake, use Ctrl+Z to undo what the rotation.
