Playing music from files on your PC has never been easier than it is in Vista. Here's how to do it.

1. From the desktop, open Music (**Figure 1**):

- 1 Left-click on Start button.
- 2 Left-click on Music.

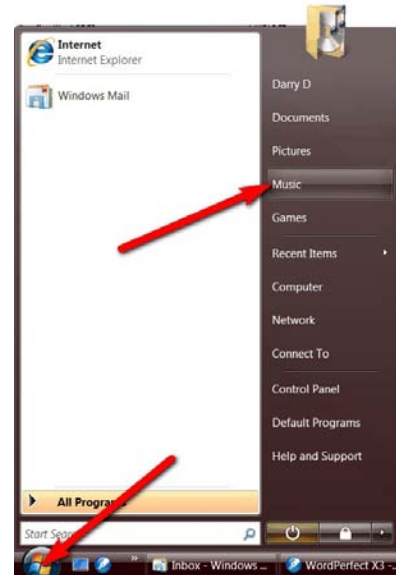

2. From the Toolbar, in the upper-left corner of the listing of the music files, Left-click on "Play All" (**Figure 2**).

You can play individual songs by Double, left-clicking on them.

You can play multiple files by selecting them and then Left-clicking on "Play all" button.

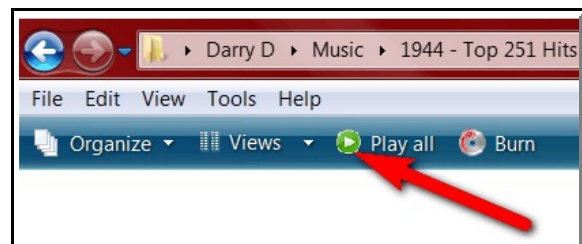
