## GRAPHIC FROM WINDOWS EXPLORER

As with previous versions of Windows, Windows 7 permits you to send graphics (photos, pictures, etc.) from Windows Explorer. However, if you send multiple graphics, controlling the order in which they are sent takes a little work. Here's how.

1. Select Start ► Pictures, and go to the graphics you want to send.
2. IF you select them in the order they are listed (**Figure 1**), they appear in reverse order in the email. However, if you select them in reverse order, they appear in the right order (**Figure 2**).

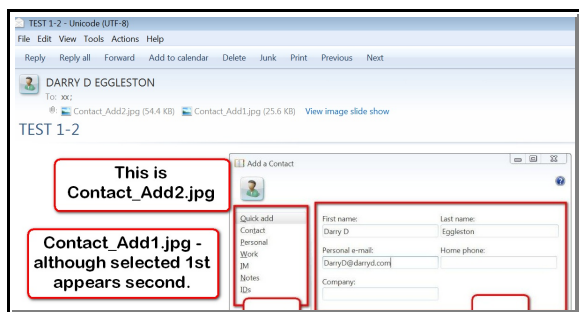

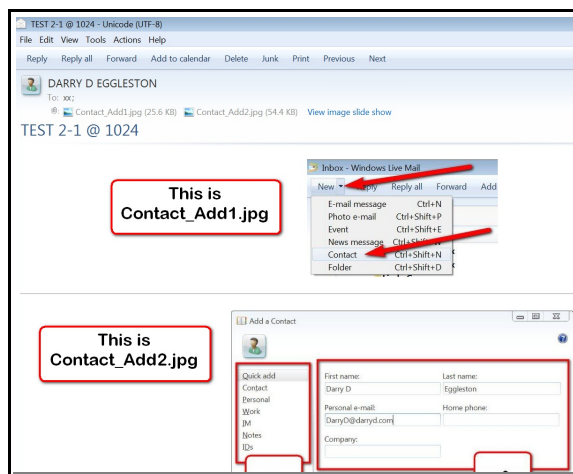
