Windows Live Mail replaces Windows Mail in Vista and acts as the free download email package for Windows 7. Here's how to set the options for it.

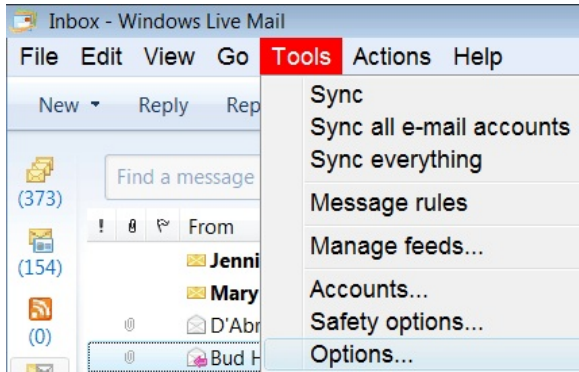

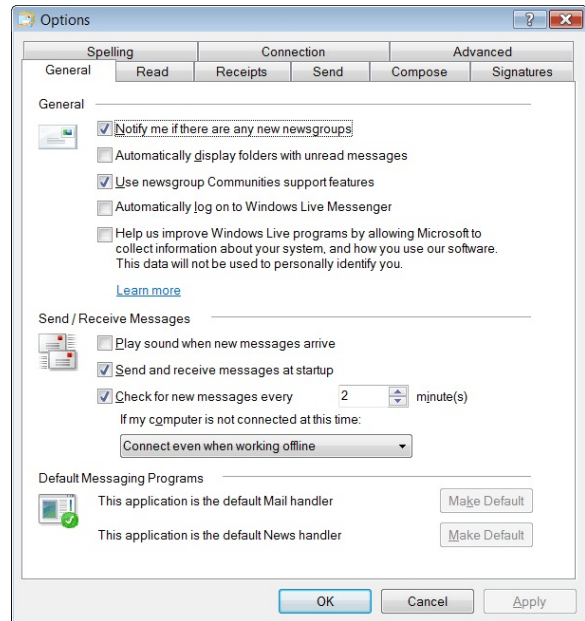

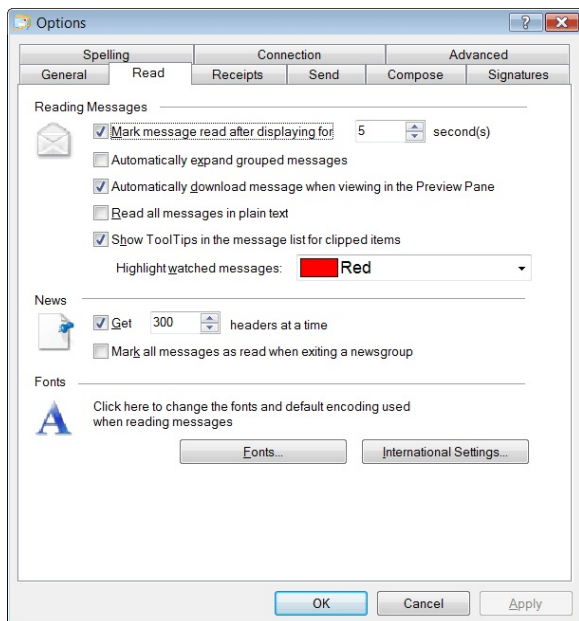

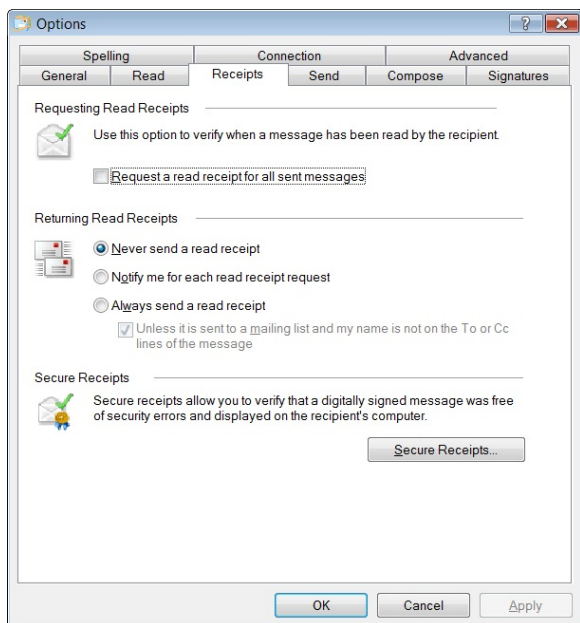

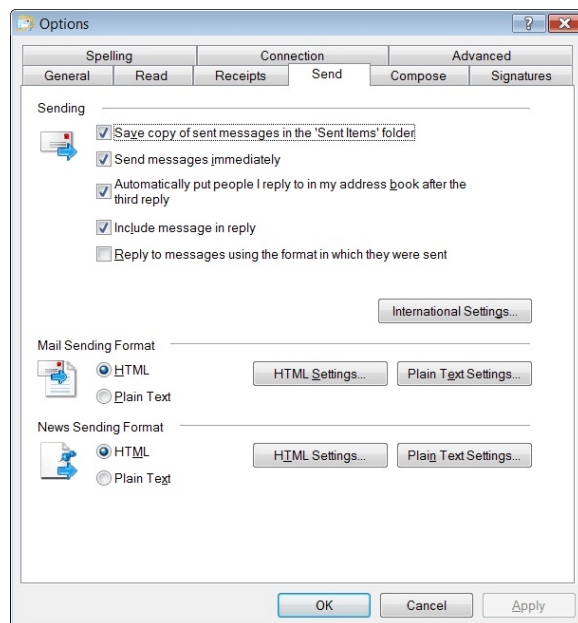

🎵 If “Send messages immediately” is not checked (**Figure 5**), your messages will go into the Outbox and you’ll have to manually send them.

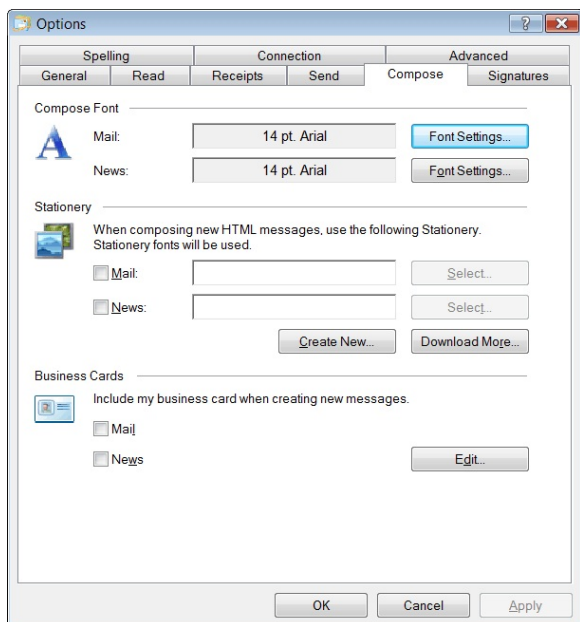

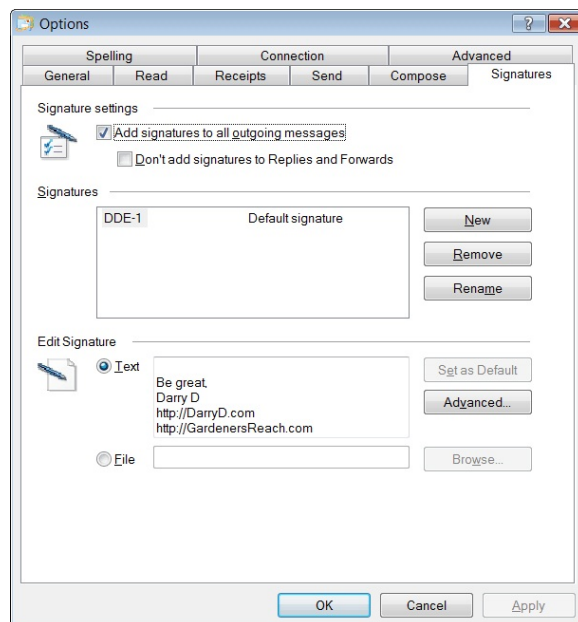

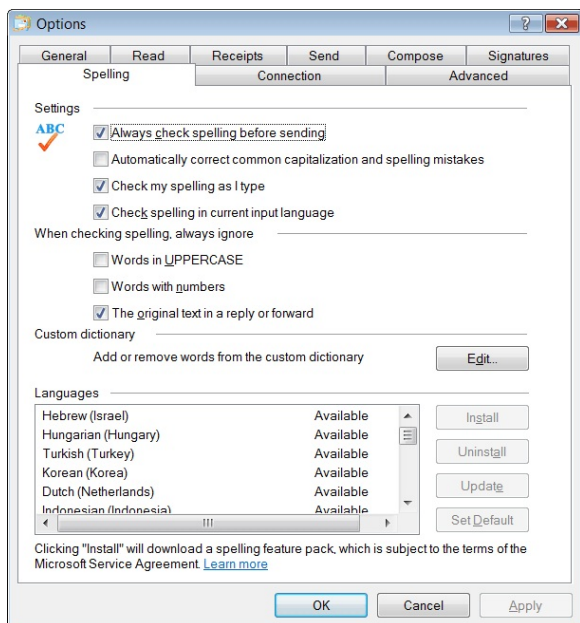

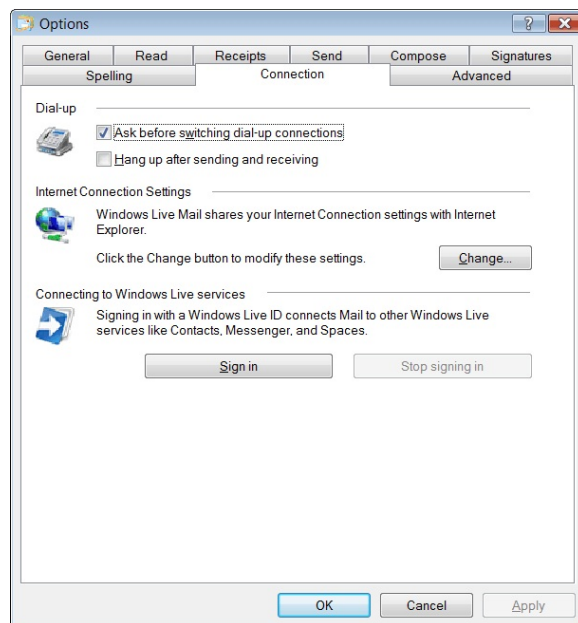

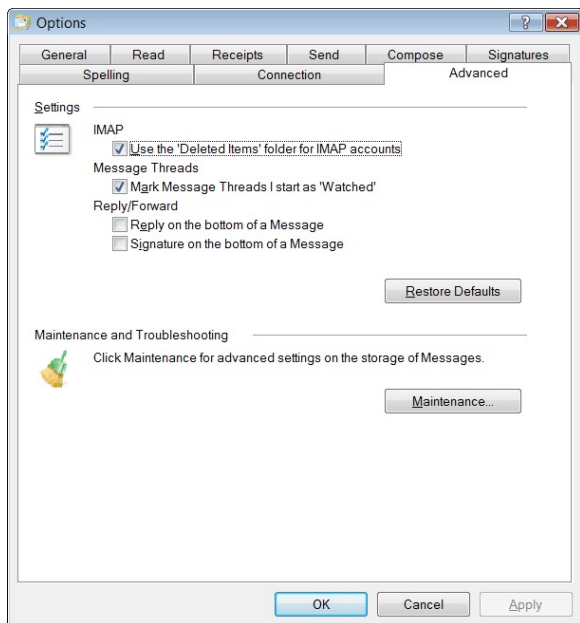
