

AVG AntiVirus UPDATE

Click on the blue, underlined text to go to its linked reference.



AVG AntiVirus automatically updates itself — most of the time. Some times there are problems getting that update completed. When this happens, the AVG icon — instead of being 4 colors: yellow, black, red and green (to the right) — becomes four shades of black.



IF you place your cursor on it, you'll see the message "E-mail scanner is not fully functional." This requires you to update your AVG AntiVirus.

The way I avoid this situation is *always* to update my AVG AntiVirus *each time* I start my PC. (Of course, I do so after my firewall loads.) Here's how I do it.

1. Open the Control Center (**Figure 1**):

➊ RIGHT-click on the AVG AntiVirus icon (to the left of the Time on the Task Bar).

➋ Left-click on "Check for Updates".

2. If the latest updates have been uploaded, you'll see **Figure 2**. IF there are updates remaining to be downloaded, follow the instructions in the Windows that appear.

If there are updates, go to Step 3.

3. If there are updates, **Figure 3** will appear on your screen indicating that AVG AntiVirus is accessing its server.

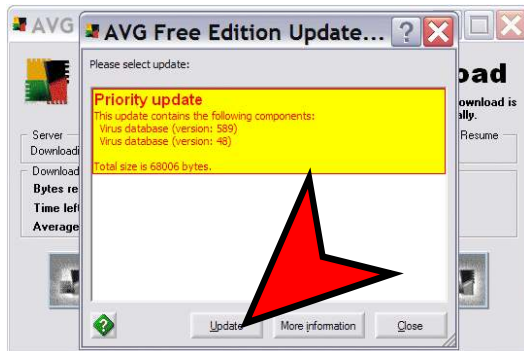

4. When AVG AntiVirus connects to its server, the “Priority Update” appears (**Figure 4**).

Left-click on “Update” button.

5. When the update is successful, **Figure 5** will appear.

You can click on the “OK” button. If you don’t, the pop-up will disappear in 30 seconds.
